All persons currently residing within Tarrant County shall stay at their place of residence, except as allowed by this Order. All persons may leave their residences only for Essential Travel and Essential Activities, to work in Essential Businesses, Government Service, or Essential Critical Infrastructure, or to perform Minimum Basic Operations. To the extent individuals are using shared or outdoor spaces, they must at all times as reasonably as possible maintain Social Distancing, This Executive Order shall take effect at 11:59 pm on the 24th day of March 2020 and shall remain in effect until April 7, 2020, unless terminated or modified by a subsequent Order."

Due to this order, <u>Peace Lutheran Church will remain closed</u> <u>through April 7, 2020</u>. This means all on-campus church activities/events, worship services and groups will not meet. However, we want to connect with you during this time. Here are some ways you can stay connected:
