- P: Baruch ata Adonai Eloheinu, Melekh Ha'olam, asher kid'shanu b'mitzvotav v'tzivanu l'hadlik ner shel Chanuka.
- C: Blessed are You, Lord our God, King of the universe, Who has sanctified us with His commandments and commanded us to kindle the Hanukkah candle.
- P: Baruch ata Adonai Eloheinu, Melekh Ha'olam, she'asa nisim la'avoteinu ba'yamim ha'heim ba'z'man ha'zeh.
- C: Blessed are You, Lord our God, King of the universe, Who performed miracles for our ancestors in those days at this time.
- P: Baruch ata Adonai Eloheinu, Melekh Ha'olam, she'hecheyanu v'kiy'manu v'higi'yanu la'z'man ha'zeh.
- C: Blessed are You, Lord our God, King of the universe, Who has kept us alive, sustained us, and enabled us to reach this moment.

READING John 10:22-30 [NIRV]

The traditional reading for the first night of Hanukkah is Numbers 7. Tonight we will read from the Gospel of John when Jesus celebrated Hanukkah.

²²Then came the Feast of Hanukkah at Jerusalem. It was winter. ²³Jesus was in the temple courtyard walking in Solomon's Porch. ²⁴The Jews who were gathered there around Jesus spoke to him. They said, "How long will you keep us waiting? If you are the Messiah, tell us plainly." ²⁵Jesus answered, "I did tell you. But you do not believe. The works that I do in my Father's name are a witness for me. ²⁶But you do not believe, because you are not my sheep. ²⁷My sheep listen to my voice. I know them, and they follow me. ²⁸I give them eternal life, and they will never die. No one will steal them out of my hand. ²⁹My Father, who has given them to me, is greater than anyone. No one can steal them out of my Father's hand. ³⁰I and the Father are one."

P: Sh'ma Yisra'eil Adonai Eloheinu Adonai echad.

Hear O Israel: the Lord our God, the Lord is One. Blessed be the name of his kingdom forever and ever. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your might. And these words which I command you this day you shall take to heart. You shall diligently teach them to your children. You shall recite them at home and away, morning and night.
