**NEW TESTAMENT LESSON** **Philippians 4:1-7** [NIV]

<sup>1</sup>Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends! <sup>2</sup>I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord. <sup>3</sup>Yes, and I ask you, my true companion, help these women since they have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the book of life.

<sup>54</sup>Then seizing him, they led him away and took him into the house of the high priest. Peter followed at a distance. <sup>55</sup>And when some there had kindled a fire in the middle of the courtyard and had sat down together, Peter sat down with them. <sup>56</sup>A servant girl saw him seated there in the firelight. She looked closely at him and said, “This man was with him.” <sup>57</sup>But he denied it. “Woman, I don’t know him,” he said. <sup>58</sup>A little later someone else saw him and said, “You also are one of them.” “Man, I am not!” Peter replied. <sup>59</sup>About an hour later another asserted, “Certainly this fellow was with him, for he is a Galilean.”

<sup>60</sup>Peter replied, “Man, I don’t know what you’re talking about!” Just as he was speaking, the rooster crowed. <sup>61</sup>The Lord turned and looked straight at Peter.
