⁹Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey. ¹⁰I will take away the chariots from Ephraim and the warhorses from Jerusalem, and the battle bow will be broken. He will proclaim peace to the nations. His rule will extend from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. ¹¹As for you, because of the blood of my covenant with you, I will free your prisoners from the waterless pit. ¹²Return to your fortress, you prisoners of hope; even now I announce that I will restore twice as much to you.

RESPONSE “Into the Holy Places”

HOLY GOSPEL **John 12:12-19** *[NIV]*

P: The next day the great crowd that had come for the festival heard that Jesus was on his way to Jerusalem. They took palm branches and went out to meet him, shouting,

C: “Hosanna!” Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!”
“Blessed is the king of Israel!”

P: Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it, just as it is written,

C: “Do not be afraid, Daughter Zion;
see, your king is coming, seated on a donkey’s colt.”

P: At first his disciples did not understand all this. Only after Jesus was glorified did they realize that these things had been written about him and that these things had been done to him. Now the crowd that was with him when he called Lazarus from the tomb and raised him from the dead continued to spread the word.

P: Many people, because they had heard that he had performed this sign, went out to meet him. So the Pharisees said to one another,

C: “See this is getting us nowhere. Look how the whole world has gone after him!”

P: This is the Gospel of the Lord. Hosanna to the Son of David!

C: Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!
