- P: Lord Jesus, Savior sent from the Father, in deep humility we confess that we have neglected to appreciate Your great sacrifice, entering time and space to die for us.
- C: We have failed to love You with our heart, soul, and mind, and we have failed to love our neighbors as ourselves. We have failed to live as Your loving brothers and sisters. Forgive us, and grant us Your own determination to love our neighbors in Your name.
- P: Holy Spirit, giver of every good gift,
- C: in deep humility we confess that we have let the faith You have planted within us to be covered with our own wants and desires. Without Your help we cannot be free; we are bound to sin. Forgive us, and renew in us clean and upright spirits. Amen.

- P: The eternal God, our Creator, Savior, and Sanctifier, has not forsaken us in our sin. For the sake of the Son, who became one of us to die for us, God offers full and free pardon. As a called and ordained servant of Christ, I therefore forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
- C: Amen.
- P: Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!
- C: You have set your glory in the heavens.
- P: Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies,
- C: To silence the foe and the avenger.
- P: When I consider your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place,
- C: What is mankind that you are mindful of them, human beings that you care for them?
- P: You have made them a little lower than the angels and crowned them with glory and honor.
- C: You made them rulers over the works of your hands; you put everything under their feet:
- P: All flocks and herds, and the animals of the wild, the birds in the sky, and the fish in the sea, all that swim the paths of the seas.
- C: Lord, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth!
- P: The Lord be with you.
- C: And also with you.
- P: Let us pray. Almighty and everlasting God, You have given us grace to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity by the confession of a true faith and to worship the Unity in the power of the Divine Majesty.
- C: Keep us steadfast in this faith and defend us from all adversities;
- P: For You, O Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, live and reign, one God, now and forever.
- C: Amen.
