

# WELCOME and RELATIONSHIPS of PEACE

### **OPENING HYMN** "All Creatures of Our God and King" [LW 436, v. 1-4]

#### **INVOCATION**

- P: In your baptism, you received the sign of the cross on your forehead and on your heart to mark you as one redeemed by Christ, the crucified.
- C: The sign of the cross always reminds us who we are and to Whom we belong.
- P: In the name of the Father and of the ₱ Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- C: We are marked with God's name, and we now live under the sign of the cross!

### **CONFESSION and ABSOLUTION** from Psalm 51

- P: Let us confess our sins to God, our Father:
- C: Have mercy on me, O God, according to your loving-kindness; in your great compassion blot out my offenses. Wash me through and through from my wickedness and cleanse me from my sin.
- P: For I know my transgressions, and my sin is ever before me.
- C: Against you only have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight.
- P: And so you are justified when you speak and upright in your judgment
- C: Indeed, I have been wicked from my birth, A sinner from my mother's womb.
- P: For behold, you look for truth deep within me, and will make me understand wisdom secretly.
- C: Purge me from my sin, and I shall be pure; wash me, and I shall be clean indeed.
- P: Make me hear of joy and gladness, that the body you have broken may rejoice.
- C: Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquities.
- P: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.
- C: Cast me not away from your presence and take not your holy Spirit from me.

- P: Give me the joy of your salvation and sustain me with your bountiful Spirit.
- C: I shall teach your ways to the wicked, and sinners shall return to you.
- P: Deliver me from death, O God, and my tongue shall sing of your righteousness, O God of my salvation.
- C: Open my lips, O Lord, and my mouth shall proclaim your praise.
- P: Had you desired it, I would have offered sacrifice; but you take no delight in burnt-offerings.
- C: The sacrifice of God is a troubled spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.
- P: May the almighty and merciful God, who desires not the death of a sinner but that we turn from wickedness and live, accept your repentance, forgive your sins, and restore you by the Holy Spirit to newness of life.
- C: Amen.

### OLD TESTAMENT LESSON Zechariah 14:12-15 [NIV]

<sup>12</sup>This is the plague with which the LORD will strike all the nations that fought against Jerusalem: Their flesh will rot while they are still standing on their feet, their eyes will rot in their sockets, and their tongues will rot in their mouths. <sup>13</sup>On that day people will be stricken by the LORD with great panic. They will seize each other by the hand and attack one another. <sup>14</sup>Judah too will fight at Jerusalem. The wealth of all the surrounding nations will be collected—great quantities of gold and silver and clothing. <sup>15</sup>A similar plague will strike the horses and mules, the camels and donkeys, and all the animals in those camps.
